PROGRAM DATES: NOV 1, 2018-NOV 15, 2019

The RUHS PA fellowship is a 12.5 month program designed to train through didactic and clinical experience Physician Assistant's to gain clinical and procedural excellence in the practice of Emergency Medicine. This education will occur under the direct supervision of Board Certified Emergency Medicine Physicians and highly experienced Advanced Providers.

Our graduates will become highly skilled, highly competent, compassionate and efficient emergency medicine providers.

RIVERSIDE UNIVERSITY – Excellence in Medical Training

Curriculum Overview

The RUHS PA Fellowship curriculum is structured on:

- American College of Emergency Physicians' (ACEP) Model of Clinical Practice
- Accreditation Review Commission on Education for the Physician Assistant (ARC-PA) Standards for Clinical Postgraduate PA Programs
 - Fellows will complete approximate 2,100 hours of care for acutely ill patients and advanced procedural experience and capability
 - Weekly didactic lecture content provided by the EM physicians and advanced provider group for elevated clinical confidence and ability in differential diagnosis, case scenarios, treatment plans, radiology and EKG review
 - o Quarterly Journal Club/Dinner at one of our physician's homes
 - Fellows will attend the Advanced Trauma and Life Support Course (ATLS) at RUHS.
 - In addition to core EM content, focused training will include clinical efficiency, documentation, billing, scribe utilization, and patient throughput
 - Focused training in malpractice risk reduction, charting for maximum reimbursement (RVU), and legal issues (EMTALA, UC to ED transfer).
 - List of targeted procedures and guided competency
 - e.g. lumbar puncture, central line, intubation, orthopedic reductions, complex laceration repair, ACLS management
 - Pre-rotation Orientation

Proposed Clinical Schedule Overview

- Core Emergency Department Time Spent: 10 months (40 weeks)
- Off Service Rotations:
 - Internal Medicine (2 weeks)
 - Intensive Care Unit (2 weeks)
 - Bedside POCUS Ultrasound Course (2.5 weeks), learn ocular, cardiac, soft tissue and abdominal ultrasound
 - Potential Specialty Rotation Tracks include (one 2 week block):
 - Trauma, Anesthesia, PICU, or EMS
- Scheduling to include overnight and weekends

Total 12 months, 2100 clinical hours in acute EM care, plus lecture time

COMPENSATION AND BENEFITS

EMPA fellows at Riverside University are paid an hourly rate and that adds up to approximately \$45,000 annually. We offer comprehensive benefits, including:

- Three weeks of paid time off per year
- 401(k) with 7.2 percent employer match and no vesting period
- Health insurance with vision, life insurance, and optional dental
 - Pre-tax savings with a Health Savings Account (HSA) or Medical Flexible Spending Account (MFSA) for out-of-pocket costs
 - A declination stipend (paid monthly) for not selecting a health insurance option
- Annual CME/CEU conference and online education options, plus a
 professional expense reimbursement benefit
- Paid malpractice insurance
